

## **MUS 441W: Listening Unit - Form**

Song: Ain't Misbehavin' – Louis Armstrong

Form: AABA

Objective: Upon hearing a familiar song in binary (AABA) form, SWBAT recognize the form by performing a certain way for each part of the form without teacher assistance.

### **Week 1**

Do "follow-the-leader" movement based on form.

### **Week 2**

Do "follow-the-leader" movement based on form.

Say, "Let's see if you can remember when we do each movement without me."

Play the song again, give reminders about movement as needed.

### **Week 3**

Students do movement while listening to song (practice once with help if needed, based on how week 2 goes), teacher holds up cards that say "A" or "B" depending on the section.

Ask students, "What did you notice about when I held up A or B?" (If they don't realize that the letters changed when their movement changed, repeat the activity so they can pay attention to it.)

### **Week 4**

Assessment: Worksheet with pictures of each movement, students circle appropriate movement at times specified by teacher.

Post-assessment: Students think of two of their own movements, they do one movement during the A section and one movement during the B section.
